Inleiding

Mosaïek is 'n kontemplatiewe, missionele geloofsgemeenskap. Hierdie beskrywing bring die volgende sake in fokus:

- › Spiritualiteit
- › Verhouding met God
- › Verhouding met mekaar
- › Verhouding met die wêreld

Dit beteken dat enige opleidingsmodel binne sodanige raamwerk aangebied moet word. Opleiding is gevolglik 'n proses van toerusting wat lei tot transformasie en wat plaasvind binne die geloofsgemeenskap en gerig is op die wêreld.

Visie

Mosaïek Akademie streef daarna om jou holisties te begelei in jou strewe om jouself beter toe te rus vir bediening en/of jou begeerte om verder te groei op jou *journey*. Ons streef daarna om studente doelgerig en effektief te begelei in geestelike, rasionele en praktiese vorming ten einde hul roeping uit te leef.

Missie

Om 'n opleidingsmodel te ontwikkel en te implementeer wat

- in die kultuur van Mosaïek Gemeente as kontemplatiewe, missionele gemeenskap is, wat
- Bybels-teologies gefundeerd is in die sentrum van die teologiese tradisies, en
- wat holisties, geïntegreerd, kontekstueel en prakties aangebied word.

Doelstellings

Ons hoofdoel:

- Om 'n opleidingsmodel daar te stel wat Bybels-teologies gefundeerd is en wat holisties, geïntegreerd en kontekstueel aangebied word.

Ook:

- om opleiding te verskaf wat die spesifieke behoeftes van volgelinge van Jesus sal aanspreek
- om studente toe te rus om hul roeping uit te leef
- om Christelike waardes in mense se lewens te vestig
- om persoonlike groei en spiritualiteit te integreer met gesonde teologie, ten einde gelowiges se verhouding met God te bevorder
- om teologie te bedryf deur in 'n geloofsgemeenskap te onderskei, die Skrifte te bestudeer en ons konteks te verken
- om studente te begelei tot 'n groter *commitment* tot hulle omgewing en geloofsgemeenskap.

Uitgangspunte van die opleiding

- Mosaiek Akademie sal 'n **holistiese benadering** tot opleiding implementeer. Dit beteken dat jou teologiese studies nie net 'n kognitiewe oefening gaan wees nie, maar ook spirituele, praktiese en fisiese komponente sal bevat. Dit sal 'n totale-mens leerervaring wees.
- Daar sal **integrasië** plaasvind. Die verskillende elemente van die opleiding sal nie in isolasie van mekaar aangebied word nie, maar al die fasette sal baie duidelik met mekaar in verband gebring word en daar sal interdissiplinêr gewerk word. Met elke vak sal jy agterkom hoe dit waarmee jy werk in die groter prentjie inpas.
- Daar sal **konteksanaliserings** van jou studies plaasvind. Dit beteken dat ons praktykgerig sal wees – hoe pas jy wat jy geleer het in JOU konteks toe?

- Die opleiding sal op 'n **goeie teologiese fondasie** rus. Hierdie fondasie vorm die basis waarop praktiese vaardighede voortbou. Dit gaan nie hier om kennis ter wille van kennis nie, maar om toegerus te word met vaardighede om die Bybel en teologiese kennis in die kontemporêre
- situasie te kan toepas. Die opleiding sal **praktykgerig** wees. Dit sal uitkomsgebaseerd wees in die sin van praktiese vaardighede wat aangeleer moet word om die "hoe" van dienswerk met groter effektiwiteit te kan hanteer. Daarom sal leraars wat in die voltydse bediening staan 'n groot rol in die opleiding speel. Daar sal praktiese werk in die opleiding ingebou word, byvoorbeeld in pastorale berading, evangelisasie en leierskapsrolspeling. Hierdie praktykgerigte opleiding sal eietyd en relevant wees vir die tyd waarin ons leef.
- Mosaïek Akademie sal **missioneel** in sy opleiding wees. Dit behels dat elke vakgebied in diens moet staan van die missiologiese opdrag aan die Kerk. Die opleiding sal daarop gerig wees om studente op te lei en toe te rus om meer effektief te wees in die uitvoering van die missiologiese opdrag van die Kerk.
- Mosaïek Akademie sal meehelp om die **karakter en spiritualiteit** van sy studente te ontwikkel. Die omgewing waarin die Kerk funksioneer, raak al hoe vyandiger teenoor die Kerk. In 'n tyd van groot stres en uitdaging, moet leraars en lidmate voorberei word om geestelik nie net te kan oorleef nie, maar te floreer: om studente te help groei na heelheid (*wholeness*) in hulle menswees.
- Mosaïek Akademie sal ook bestaande **tegnologie** inspan om die opleiding so doeltreffend moontlik vir studente te maak. Alhoewel interne opleiding die kern van die opleiding sal vorm, sal die internet en ander tegnologiese middele tot ons beskikking ook ingespan word om so effektief moontlik diens te lewer. Die opleiding sal, sover moontlik, multimedia-gerig wees.
- Mosaïek Akademie sal **ekumenies** in benadering wees. Dit beteken dat studente van enige kerklike agtergrond hier 'n tuiste kan vind. Dosente sal ook 'n ekumeniese benadering weerspreek.

The community benefits from being served by individuals who progress to this level of leadership. You will be enabled to apply your knowledge in the context of church ministry, personal enrichment and in academic endeavours.

On completion of this module, you should be able to:

- Understand and explain the multi-dimensional role of leaders within a 21st century context.
- Identify and develop a growth plan for their development areas in each dimension (spiritual, emotional, intellectual and social).
- Integrate and give proof of the impact of the above on the learner's life, leadership and ministry.

Pastoral Counseling is an applied branch of theology and psychology that strives to promote the emotional and spiritual health and well being of people in various contexts. This discipline is of particular relevance in the quest to effectively deal with emotional and spiritual problems and empower people through personal growth. This course will have systems epistemology and narrative psychology approach that is grounded in the Christian religion.

On completion of this module, you should be able to:

- To equip the student with very basic counseling skills.
- To present the student with some basic theoretical perspectives regarding counseling, psychology and theology.
- To give the student some practical experience within the field of pastoral counseling and to integrate this practice with theory.
- To assist the student also with their own personal growth and learning.
- To assist the student to be able to do effective support giving in the community.
- To further the student's interest within the field and continue learning and also developing their own personal growth both interpersonally and within the community.

A study in Youth Ministry is important because it equips a student with the abilities and skills necessary to execute a youth ministry that will nurture spiritual growth, while exploring both the youth worker and the youth group's long-term challenges. You will gain an understanding of your own spirituality and enable constant spiritual growth, explore the challenges of youth ministry leadership and how to build up a team of leaders around you. You will comprehend the challenges of postmodern youth ministry and be able to approach your ministry holistically. You will know the main skills necessary for communicating with youth. You will grasp the principle of building a theological framework for various relevant ethical questions. You will be able to construct a process of spiritual formation in a youth ministry.

On completion of this module, you should be able to:

- Know and describe your own spirituality and ministry style.
- Understand postmodern youth ministry.
- Understand various challenges among youth.
- Approach ethical questions in youth ministry from a theological framework.
- Understand and apply the principle of holistic youth ministry.
- Communicate effectively with youth.
- Design a curriculum that will address the various challenges of a specific youth group and lead them towards spiritual formation.

Ingevolge hulle akkreditasie by die Departement van Onderwys, mag SATS grade aanbied tot op doktorale vlak. Die ooreenkoms wat Mosaïek met SATS bereik het, behels die volgende:
