“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”

1. To become a partner with Christ is addressed.

Notice first to whom this gospel invitation to become a partner with Christ is addressed.

‘Come to me all of you who are weary and burdened...’
(verse 28)

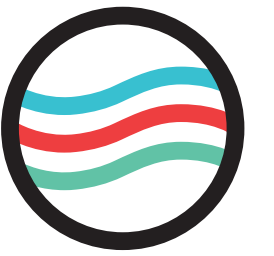
2. To become a partner with Christ has two parts.

Notice second that this gospel invitation to become a partner with Christ has two parts.

On the one hand, notice that Christ himself calls us into partnership with himself.

‘Come to me...’ (verse 28)

On the other hand, notice that this partnership involves taking Christ's yoke upon ourselves.

'Take my yoke upon you and learn from me.' (Verse 29)

3. We discover life at its best.

Notice lastly that when we respond to this gospel invitation, we discover life at its best.

'and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.' (verse 30)
